Average Salary by Location

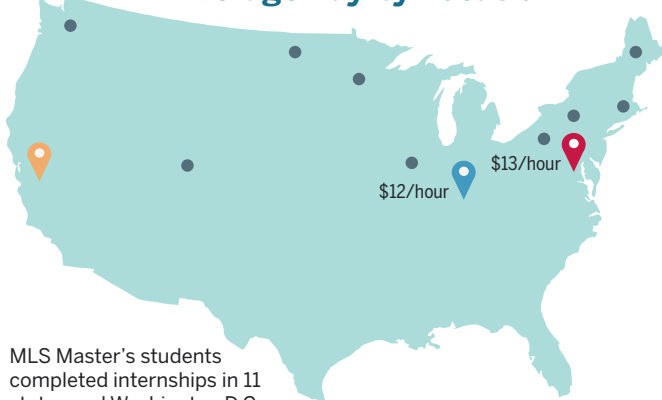


MLS graduates accepted full-time positions in 19 states plus Washington D.C. and China.
